



**Management Intent for Tlingit Tlatsini Areas**  
(From TRTFN. 2003. *Ha Tlatgi Ha Khustiyyxh siti: Our Land is Our Future*, p. 88)

**Maintain natural ecological conditions and processes over large landscapes** to sustain biodiversity and TRT traditional uses. Provide opportunities for compatible, low-intensity developments.

This proposal addresses sub-regional scale protected areas; additional work is required to identify landscape or site level protected areas identified by the Tlingit and local Atlin community (such as Monarch Mountain, Pine Creek beach, Warm Springs, etc.)

**Dakh Ka Nations**  
Further to the May 1, 2006 Memorandum of Understanding between the Dakh Ka Nations, work is currently underway to gather information on the interests and perspectives of the Carcross Tagish First Nation and Teslin Tlingit Council. On-going dialogue among the Dakh Ka Nations may lead to additions and/or refinements to this map proposal.

**CESMF**  
Further to the Culturally and Ecologically Sustainable Management Framework (CESMF) developed by BC and the TRTFN under the *Framework Agreement for Shared Decision Making Respecting Land Use and Wildlife Management*, additional work is required to identify Resource Management Zones (RMZs) with area-specific management direction to address specific cultural, ecological or other values.
